## COOBER PEDY 2021 NEWSLETTER

The birds in the final race for the year were released at 7:00 am Friday with 1121 SAHPA birds. The weather upon release was fine and clear with a 14 km/h easterly wind. The wind direction changed along the journey home and towards the end was a strong north westerly.

The race was won by **One More Chance (David Cunningham & Arthur Martin)** with **Clarke & Sheppard** second and **Phoenix Lofts Australia 4** third. The winning velocity was 1391.108 mpm. Congratulations to the winners and all of the other prize winners.

The sire of the winner, bred by Greg Hamilton, is a Heremans Ceusters being a son of the Syndicate Cock and Good As Gold who has bred winners and clocked birds. The dam that flew for 3 seasons (landed with clocked bird 5 times) is from David's long distance family. She flew Marla 3 times and Kulgera once. Her sire was 1<sup>st</sup> Club 3<sup>rd</sup> NAHPA Marla and bred 1<sup>st</sup> Alice Springs. Her dam was bred from a pair of Alice Springs winners. Blood lines being Port Pirie Pied, Goodger, Metcalfe and Dordin.

The sire of second is an inbred son of a hen that was clocked 5 times with a sister having been clocked 7 times. He is a Van Loon, Barker and SP Griffiths cross. The dam is bred down from a hen that was second Tasmania National with only two birds home on the day. She is a Bricoux, Barker and SP Griffiths cross.

The sire of third is a Heremans Ceusters along the Samson lines bred down from the Marina Vandeveldel star. The dam is a Marcellis.

**MKRP (Mark King & Richard Placente)** won the Aggregate Points whilst **South Bunbury (Colin Hosking & John May)** won the Bird of the Year with Bunbury 20 0077 BCH.

Registrations and deposits for the 2022 season are being received. The team size is **5 birds**. **The entry fee is \$1,540 per team including GST with the deposit \$540.**

Birds sent via **Adelaide Airport must be sent on either Friday the 26<sup>th</sup> November or Friday the 3<sup>rd</sup> December.** Do not send birds on any other days.
